PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Your December 13, 2019 application for Public Assistance is APPROVED from January 26, 2020 to July 31, 2020.

The following individuals will receive Public Assistance:

JANE DOE

Beginning January 26, 2020 you will get \$339.50 in Public Assistance per month. The amount you receive for the first month may be less than this because you were approved for only a part of the month.

This is because we must figure your first month's benefit from the forty-fifth (45th) day following your application for assistance to the end of the month.

Your first Public Assistance cash grant will become available on March 27, 2020.

Please refer to the distribution section below to see how your benefit will be paid.

Your first month's public assistance benefit of \$339.50 will be distributed as follows:

- o Semi-monthly cash grant: \$15.25
- o Restricted shelter payment: \$309.00

Beginning February 1, 2020 you will get \$492.00 in Public Assistance each month.

Your cash grant will be available in two parts. The first half cash grant will be available on the ninth of the month. The second half cash grant will be available on the twentyfourth of the month. Please refer to the distribution section below to see how your benefit will be paid.

Your monthly public assistance benefit of \$492.00 for the period from February 1, 2020 to July 31, 2020 will be distributed as follows:

- o Semi-monthly cash grant: \$91.50
- o Restricted shelter payment: \$309.00

If you have any changes in your household such as increased rent or someone else moving in, tell your worker right away. A change in your household could mean a change in your benefit amount.

Please see the budget calculation section of this notice for an explanation of how we figured your benefit amount.

This decision is based on Regulation 18 NYCRR 351.2(d).

You asked us in writing to pay your public assistance grant in the following way:

- o We will take \$309.00 and pay it directly to your landlord. If your rent is more than this amount, you must pay the rest to your landlord.

This decision is based on Regulation 18 NYCRR 381.3.
