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**Tickets in COMPASS - Terms of Service**

Access to DMV's Tickets in COMPASS is restricted to the District Attorney and personnel authorized by such District Attorney. DMV reserves the right to terminate access at any time, without prior notice, in the event of any unauthorized access or misuse of information provided hereunder.

The District Attorney or District Attorney personnel authorized by such District Attorney will comply with the following:

1. Tickets in COMPASS must **only** be used in conjunction with the prosecution of **traffic tickets**.
2. The user access credentials must not be shared with anyone.
3. Users will only access personal information contained in the Tickets in COMPASS function in conformance with the federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994 (DPPA) (18 U.S.C. §2721, et seq.). Users must report suspected or confirmed violations of the DPPA to the DMV risk management office at nysdmvriskmanagement@dmv.ny.gov within 1 business day of discovering any such violation.
4. Users agree to indemnify, keep and hold harmless the State of New York, its agents, officials and employees, from any and all claims for injury or damage to person or property, deaths, losses, damages, suits directly attributed to the negligent, improper or unauthorized use or dissemination of personal identifying information provided hereunder.
5. Record keeping:
  - Users must maintain records of searches made using Tickets in COMPASS for 5 years from the date the search was conducted.
  - Records of searches conducted will be promptly provided to DMV upon request.
  - Records must be organized to permit retrieval by the license number of the subject of the search.

**CERTIFICATION**

I certify that I have read, understand, and will comply with the DPPA and the terms of service for tickets in COMPASS. I certify that if I receive or have access to records or information from the DMV, I shall not (i) use such records or information for civil immigration purposes or (ii) disclose such records or information to any agency that primarily enforces immigration law, such as U.S. immigration and customs enforcement and U.S. customs and border protection, or to any employee or agent of any such agency unless such disclosure is pursuant to a cooperative arrangement between city, state and federal agencies which does not enforce immigration law and which disclosure is limited to the specific records or information being sought pursuant to such arrangement. I certify that, in addition to the requirements of 18 USC 2721(c), I shall keep for a period of five years records of all uses and identifying each person or entity that primarily enforces immigration law that received department records or information from such certifying person or entity. I shall maintain the records in a manner and form prescribed by the commissioner, and I shall make them available for inspection upon the commissioner's request.
