C) You must provide the number of proofs below as shown by your choice in Section B.

If you are under 21, your parent/guardian may submit a Statement of Identity and/or Residence by Parent/Guardian (form MV-45) along with their New York State Driver License or Non-Driver ID Card (must show current address). No additional proofs are required from Section C.

Current address must appear pre-printed on the two documents that must show your current New York State address (P.O. Box is not acceptable). Electronic statements and e-bills must be printed. Only one of each proof can be accepted.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Complete Application for Permit, Driver License or Non-Driver ID Card (form MV-44).
2. Present required proofs of identification.
3. License and Learner Permit applicants must pass a Vision Test.
4. Learner Permit applicants must also pass a knowledge test.
5. Pay fees. You can pay with credit card, cash, or check or money order payable to: "Commissioner of Motor Vehicles".

REQUIREMENTS:

- Full Legal Name:
 - ◆ The combination of your full legal name - first, middle (if applicable), last and suffix (if applicable). This full name will appear on your card.
 - ◆ If your name has changed due to marriage, divorce, or legal name change, you must bring original or certified copies documenting the change (marriage certificate, divorce decree, court issued documents). If your name has changed multiple times, you must bring multiple documents that link all names.
- Mutilated Documents:
 - ◆ DMV will not accept any damaged or mutilated documents, or documents with any alterations or erasures. DMV will confiscate any document that appears to be fraudulent. If you submit a fraudulent document, you could be subject to criminal prosecution.
- One Proof Per Source:
 - ◆ DMV will not accept more than one document of the same type of proof or from the same source. For example, DMV will accept only one major credit card statement or one utility bill, or DMV will not accept a bank statement and a credit card statement from the same financial institution.
- Current New York State Address:
 - ◆ Each document must show your current address in New York State.
 - ◆ An address with a P.O. box is not acceptable.
 - ◆ Your current address will appear on your REAL ID or Enhanced document.
 - ◆ If you cannot meet the requirements listed above, you may submit as an additional proof, one of the following:
 - Certificate of Residence (form MV-44NYR)
 - Postmarked mail dated within 90 days of application
 - Current address documents that are in your spouse's name (or parents name if under 21) if:
 - ▶ you have the same last name, **OR**
 - ▶ you show additional documents that prove your relationship (for example, a marriage certificate).
- Foreign Passport:
 - ◆ If you are submitting a foreign passport as proof of lawful status, you must have either:
 - a valid Visa and an I-94 issued by Immigration & Naturalization Service/Department of Homeland Security or Stamp Issued by Customs & Border Patrol
 - a valid I-551 stamp - Type of Lawful Status determined by Department of Homeland Security verification
 - a valid I-551 statement on the Visa - Type of Lawful Status determined by Department of Homeland Security verification
- Temporary Lawful Status:
 - ◆ If you have temporary lawful status, be prepared to show current documentation.
