

DEALER/TRANSPORTER Registration Classes

There are three registration classes that do not have a VIN associated with the registration record. For these registration classes, insurers are required to file transactions electronically:

1. **Dealer (DLR-62)** - A dealer is a person, firm, association, or corporation engaged in the retail or wholesale business of buying, selling, or dealing in motor vehicles. DMV issues dealer plates to NYS dealers who are registered with NYS DMV. Dealer plates are used to operate any vehicle owned or controlled by the dealer and held for sale or demonstration. For retail dealers, the required wording on an Insurance ID Card instead of a specific VIN is "DEALER GARAGE AUTO LIABILITY POLICY" or "ALL OWNED AND NON-OWNED VEHICLES-COMPREHENSIVE AUTO LIABILITY POLICY". The wording for wholesale dealers is "AUTO LIABILITY POLICY".

2. **Motorcycle Dealer (MCD-64)** - A motorcycle dealer is a person, firm, association, or corporation registered as a NYS dealer engaged in the retail or wholesale business of buying, selling, or dealing in motorcycles. Motorcycle dealer plates are used for the operation of any motorcycle owned or controlled by the dealer and held for sale or demonstration. For retail dealers, the required wording on an Insurance ID Card instead of a specific VIN is "DEALER GARAGE AUTO LIABILITY POLICY" or "ALL OWNED AND NON-OWNED VEHICLES-COMPREHENSIVE AUTO LIABILITY POLICY". The wording for wholesale dealers is "AUTO LIABILITY POLICY".

3. **Transporter (TRA-66)** - Transporter plates are issued to a registered dealer or to any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in a business requiring the limited operation of motor vehicles to deliver, repair or improve or install. Transporter plates may also be used on vehicles owned by a manufacturer for demonstration purposes. The required Insurance ID Card wording is "AUTO LIABILITY POLICY".

In 2006, NYS DMV began accepting electronic insurance transactions for these registration classes. As of January, 2008, an electronic filing for these classes was mandatory.

MANDATORY VERIFICATION

When a registration and license plate are issued or paper proof of insurance is entered, DMV will send an electronic MVF to the insurer the next day.

INSURANCE TRANSACTIONS

In addition to the other EDI data segments, the following values are required for dealer/transporter registrations:

Must contain the actual NYS plate number

ERROR CODES

Error Code Description

E125 Plate number not provided for dealer/transporter registrant

E130 Dealer/transporter transaction submitted for other FS or FH record

E135 Transaction type invalid for dealer/transporter registrant

E685 VIN invalid for dealer/transporter registrant

E686 Vehicle century invalid for policy type 8

E687 Vehicle year invalid for policy type 8

E688 Vehicle make invalid for policy type 8

U100 Unmatched Record - Plate Hit

U105 Associated NYS DMV registrant information

U900 Unmatched record - No plate or name hit
